two queens joined by blood and rivals for the throne only one would survive their decades long power play mary stuart is a fictionalised essay about mary queen of scots mary s reign in scotland was marked by scandal her first husband was murdered and she was heavily implicated in the crime forced to flea to england mary counted on the support of her cousin elizabeth i but elizabeth feared that mary had her sights set on the english crown so she imprisoned her and began building a case for her execution dumas portrays his protagonist as an enigmatic figure driven by lust and a thirst for power this story is a great

companion to the many movies about mary such as mary queen of scots starring margot robbie and saoirse ronan alexandre dumas 1802 1870 was a hugely popular 19th century french writer born of mixed french and haitian heritage dumas first rose to prominence in paris as a playwright but later gained international fame with his historical fiction often co authored with other writers these stories wove together swashbuckling adventure romance and real events from france s past among the best known are the three musketeers and its sequels twenty years after and le vicomte de bragelonne ten years later set across four decades this trilogy follows the rise of the dashing d artagnan from hot headed soldier to trusted captain under louis xiv dumas other novels include the count of monte cristo and the black tulip his works have been adapted into more than 200 movies including the man in the iron mask starring leonardo dicaprio

this book examines the 1583 voyage of sir humphrey gilbert to north america this was england s first attempt at colonization beyond the british isles yet it has not been subject to thorough scholarly analysis for more than 70 years an exhaustive examination of the voyage reveals the complexity and preparedness of this and similar early modern colonizing expeditions prominent elizabethans assisted gilbert by researching and investing in his expedition the printing revolution was critical to their plans as gilbert s supporters traveled throughout england with promotional literature proving england s claim to north america gilbert s experts used maps and charts to publicize and navigate while his pilots experimented with new navigating tools and practices though he failed to establish a settlement gilbert created a blueprint for later stuart colonizers who achieved his vision of a british empire in the western hemisphere this book clarifies the role of cartography natural science and promotional literature in elizabethan colonization and elucidates the preparation stages of early modern colonizing voyages

candide is a french satire by voltaire a philosopher of the age of enlightenment it begins with a young man candide who is living a sheltered life in an edenic paradise and being indoctrinated with leibnizian optimism or simply optimism by his mentor pangloss the work describes the abrupt cessation of this lifestyle followed by candide s slow painful disillusionment as he witnesses and experiences great hardships in the world voltaire concludes with candide if not rejecting optimism outright advocating a deeply practical precept we must cultivate our garden in lieu of the leibnizian mantra of pangloss all is for the best in the best of all possible worlds candide is characterized by its sarcastic tone as well as by its erratic fantastical and fast moving plot a picaresque novel it parodies many adventure and romance clichés the struggles of which are caricatured in a tone that is mordantly matter of fact still the events discussed are often based on historical happenings such as the seven years war and the 1755 lisbon earthquake as philosophers of voltaire s day contended with the problem of evil so too does candide in this short novel albeit more directly and humorously voltaire ridicules religion theologians governments armies philosophies and philosophers through allegory most conspicuously he assaults leibniz and his optimism as expected by voltaire candide has enjoyed both great success and great scandal immediately after its secretive publication the book was widely banned because it contained religious blasphemy political sedition and intellectual hostility hidden under a thin veil of naïveté however with its sharp wit and insightful portrayal of the human condition the novel has since inspired many later authors and artists to mimic and adapt it today candide is recognized as voltaire s magnum opus and is often listed as part of the western canon it is arguably taught more than any other work of french literature it was listed as one of the 100 most influential books ever written

with almost 5 million copies sold in the 60 years since it was published generations of readers have

originally published in 1987 lady rachel russell 1637 1723 was regarded as one of the best women by many of the most powerful people of her time wife of lord william russell the prominent whig opponent of king charles ii who was executed for treason in 1683 lady russell emerged as a political figure in her own right during the glorious revolution and throughout her forty year widowhood award winning historian lois g schwoerer has written a biography that illuminates both the political life and the lives of women in late stuart england lady russell s interest in politics and religion blossomed during her marriage to lord russell and after his death as william became a whig martyr rachel became a whig saint her wealth contacts and role as her husband s surrogate gave her considerable influence to intercede in high government appointments lend support in elections and exchange favors with her friend mary of orange in her domestic life she similarly took steps usually reserved to men managing large estates in london and hampshire and negotiating favorable marriage contracts for each of her three children although lady russell was unusual for her time she was by no means unique other notable women shared her concerns and traits although to differing degrees and effects schwoerer suggests that the horizons of women s lives in the seventeenth century may have extended farther than is often supposed

a p hill lee s forgotten general is the first biography of the confederacy s long neglected hero whom lee ranked next to jackson and longstreet although the name and deeds of this gallant virginian conspicuously punctuate the record of every major campaign of the army of northern virginia the man himself has persistently remained what douglas southall freman termed an elusive personality william woods hassler through careful and persistent research has compiled an interesting documentary study from which emerges a balanced portrait of this distinguished but complex character here for the first time is detailed the romantic triangle which enmeshed hill and mcclellan former roommates at west point with beauteous nelly marcy reigning queen of pre war washington s younger set hill lost this contest to nelly s parents but he later won the hand of general john hunt morgan s lovely and talented sister dolly and at sharpsburg hill wreaked vengeance upon mcclellan by his timely arrival which saved lee from defeat at the same time it spelled mcclellan's subsequent dismissal from command of the army of the potomac the author traces hill s meteoric rise from colonel of the redoubtable thirteenth virginia regiment to major general in command of the famed light division against a you are there background of intimate detail the reader follows the exploits of tempestous ambrose powell hill as he welds his officers and men into fierce striking units where the fighing is thickests there is the red haired red shirted hill brandishing his sword and exhorting his men to victory sometimes the issue ends ignominiously as at bristoe station but more often the outcome is glorious as at second manassas and reams station gray greats and near greats stalk through these pages with vivid reality as one meets jeb stuart dorsey pender john hood heros von borcke ham chamerlayne willie pegram rev j wm jones cadmus wilcox harry heth j r anderson lawrence o brien branch james archer jim lane thomas wooten charles field george tucker kyd douglas johnston pettigrew moxley sorrel william h palmer wade hampton jube early lindsay walker maxcy gregg sam mcgowan and others accompanying hill and his commands from pre manassas to the final breakthrough at petersburg the reader relives the campaigns in the eastern theater at the same time the reader gains a deeper insight into the problems of command together with an appreciation of the hardships which the confederate soldiers endured during even the early days of the conflict although powell hill s consideration and ability
