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steven spielberg is one of the screen s greatest enchanters with a spellbinding capacity and a box office record matched by very few in this first full biography of spielberg the author of the hollywood exiles and the cinema of john ford examines how this movie brat from an unhappy and rootless adolescence became one of the most formidable players on the global entertainment scene of photos

steven spielberg is known as the most powerful man in new hollywood and a pioneer of the contemporary blockbuster america s most successful export his career began a new chapter in mass culture at the same time american post war liberalism was breaking down this fascinating new book explains the complex relationship between film and politics through the prism of an iconic filmmaker spielberg s early films were a triumphant emergence of the sunbelt aesthetic that valued visceral kicks and basic emotions over the ambiguities of history such blockbusters have inspired much debate about their negative effect on politics and have been charged as being an expression of the corporatization of life here frederick wasser argues that the older spielberg has not fully gone this way suggesting that the filmmaker recycles the populist vision of older hollywood because he sincerely believes in both big time moviemaking and liberal democracy nonetheless his stories are burdened by his generation s hostility to public life and the book shows how he uses filmmaking tricks to keep his audience with him and to smooth over the ideological contradictions his audiences have become more global as his films engage history this fresh and provocative take on spielberg in the context of globalization rampant market capitalism and the hardening socio political landscape of the united states will be fascinating reading for students of film and for anyone interested in contemporary america and its culture

j g ballard's collected nonfiction from 1962 to 2007 mapping the cultural obsessions experiences and insights of one of the most original minds of his generation j g ballard was a colossal figure in english literature and an imaginative force of the twentieth century alongside seminal novels from the notorious crash 1973 to the semi autobiographical empire of the sun 1984 ballard was a sought after reviewer and commentator publishing journalism memoir and cultural criticism in a variety of forms this volume collects the most significant short nonfiction of ballard's fifty year career extending the range of the only previous collection of his nonfiction a user's guide to the millennium 1996 which selected essays and reviews published between 1962 and 1995 a decade on from ballard's death in 2009 a new generation of readers needs a new collection in the period following a user's guide ballard's writing addressed 9 11 british politics from new labour onward and what he termed the rise of soft fascism a diagnosis that maintains its relevance amid a shift toward right populism in european and us politics beautifully edited by ballard scholar and novelist mark blacklock this volume includes ballard's editorials and manifestos commentaries on his own work commentaries on the work of others reviews and more above all it makes the case for the currency of ballard's work at a contemporary juncture at which so many of his diagnoses concerning the media and politics have become apparent

the director's authorial role in filmmaking the extent to which a film reflects his or her individual style and creative vision has been much debated among film critics and scholars for decades drawing on generations of criticism this study describes how the designation auteur has gone from stylistic criterion to product label in what has always been an essentially collaborative industry examining the controversy in regard to hollywood directors the author compares directors and would be auteurs of the classic studio system with those of contemporary hollywood and its new climate of cultural entrepreneurship

on sunset boulevard originally published in 1998 describes the life of acclaimed filmmaker billy wilder 1906 2002 director of such classics as sunset boulevard the lost weekend the seven year itch and sabrina this definitive biography takes the reader on a fast paced journey from billy wilder's birth outside of krakow in 1906 to vienna where he grew up to berlin where he moved as a young man while establishing himself as a journalist and screenwriter and triumphantly to hollywood where he became as successful a director as there ever was double indemnity sunset boulevard some like it hot and the apartment wilder's cinematic legacy is unparalleled not only did he direct these classics and twenty one other films he co wrote all of his own screenplays volatile cynical hilarious and driven wilder arrived in hollywood an all but penniless refugee who spoke no english ten years later he was calling his own shots and he stayed on top of the game for the next three decades wilder battled with humphrey bogart

marilyn monroe bing crosby and peter sellers kept close friendships with william holden audrey hepburn jack lemmon and walter matthau amassed a personal fortune by way of blockbuster films and shrewd investments in art including picassos klee's and miris and won oscars yet wilder ever conscious of his thick accent always felt the sting of being an outsider on sunset boulevard traces the course of a turbulent but fabulous life both behind the scenes and on the scene from viennese cafes and berlin dance halls in the twenties to the hollywood soundstages of the forties and the on location shoots of the fifties and sixties crammed with wilder's own caustic wit on sunset boulevard reels out the story of one of cinema's most brilliant and prolific talents

some acting careers are made by one great role and some fall into obscurity when one is declined would al pacino be the star he is today if robert redford had accepted the role of michael corleone in the godfather imagine tom hanks rejecting uma thurman saying that she acted like someone in a high school play when she auditioned to play opposite him in the bonfire of the vanities picture danny thomas as the godfather or marilyn monroe as cleopatra this reference work lists hundreds of such stories actors who didn't get cast or who turned down certain parts each entry organized alphabetically by film title gives the character and actor cast a list of other actors considered for that role and the details of the casting decision information is drawn from extensive research and interviews from about last night which john belushi turned down at his brother's urging to zulu in which michael caine was not cast because he didn't look cockney enough this book lets you imagine how different your favorite films could have been

spy businessman bon vivant nazi party member righteous gentile this was oskar schindler the controversial man who saved eleven hundred jews during the holocaust but struggled afterwards to rebuild his life and gain international recognition for his wartime deeds david crowe examines every phase of schindler's life in this landmark biography presenting a savior of mythic proportions who was also an opportunist and spy who helped nazi germany conquer poland schindler is best known for saving over a thousand jews by putting them on the famed schindler's list and then transferring them to his factory in today's czech republic in reality schindler played only a minor role in the creation of the list through no fault of his own plagued by local efforts to stop the movement of jewish workers from his factory in krakóo his new one in brüz and his arrest by the ss who were investigating corruption charges against the infamous amon gö schindler had little say or control over his famous list the tale of how the list was really prepared is one of the most intriguing parts of the schindler story that crowe tells here for the first time forced into exile after the war success continually eluded schindler and he died in very poor health in 1974 he remained a controversial figure even in death particularly after emilie schindler his wife of forty six years began to criticize her husband after the appearance of steven spielberg's film in 1993 in oskar schindler crowe steps beyond the mythology that has grown up around the story of oskar schindler and looks at the life and work of this man whom one prominent schindler jew described as an extraordinary man in extraordinary times

the cinema isn't a slice of life it's a slice of cake alfred hitchcock if you make a popular movie you start to think where have i failed woody allen a film is the world in an hour and a half jean luc godard i think you have to be slightly psychopathic to make movies david cronenberg this compendium contains more than 3 400 quotations from filmmakers and critics discussing their craft about 1 850 film people are included bunuel capra chaplin disney fellini fitzgerald griffith kael kurasawa pathe sarris schwarzenegger spielberg waters and welles among them the quotations are arranged under 31 topics such as acting animation audience budget casting critics costume design directing locations reviews screenwriting special effects and stardom indexing by filmmakers or critics by film titles and by narrow subjects provides a rich array of points of access
