discusses the history religious practices and social life of the romaniote jews of ioannina  
greece a community which dates back at least to the 9th century describes the varying  
responses to jews both tolerant and intolerant of byzantine and other rulers until 1430  
during the ottoman period 1430 1913 jews had the subordinate status of dhimmi and  
suffered some persecutions such as on 15 april 1872 the eve of the greek easter under the  
nazi german occupation the majority of the 1 950 jews of ioannina were arrested in march  
1944 and deported to auschwitz 112 returned but the present jewish community is  
dwindling

*k e fleming s greece a jewish history* is the first comprehensive english language history of  
greek jews and the only history that includes material on their diaspora in israel and the  
united states the book tells the story of a people who for the most part no longer exist and  
whose identity is a paradox in that it wasn t fully formed until after most greek jews had  
emigrated or been deported and killed by the nazis for centuries jews lived in areas that are  
now part of greece but greek jews as a nationalized group existed in substantial number  
only for a few short decades from the balkan wars 1912 13 until the holocaust in which  
more than 80 percent were killed greece a jewish history describes their diverse histories  
and the processes that worked to make them emerge as a greek collective it also follows  
jews as they left greece as deportees to auschwitz or émigrés to palestine israel and new  
york s lower east side in such foreign settings their greekness was emphasized as it never  
was in greece where orthodox christianity traditionally defines national identity and anti  
semitism remains common

for the sizeable jewish community living in greece during the 1940s german occupation of  
greece posed a distinct threat the nazis and their collaborators murdered around ninety  
percent of the jewish population through the course of the war this new account presents  
cutting edge research on four elements of the holocaust in greece the level of antisemitism

and question of collaboration the fate of jewish property before during and after their deportation how the few surviving jews were treated following their return to greece especially in terms of justice and restitution and the ways in which jewish communities rebuilt themselves both in greece and abroad taken together these elements point to who was to blame for the disaster that befell jewish communities in greece and show that the occupation authorities alone could not have carried out these actions to such magnitude without the active participation of greek christians

the illusion of safety chronicles the little known history of the holocaust in greece through a collection of personal memoirs of survivors and resistance fighters and wartime reports from the u s state department and great britain michael matsas recounts the tragic loss of greek jewry late in wwii while the allied governments knew about hitler s final solution and had the means to disseminate information in greece the greek jews were kept uninformed of the death camps and lulled into complacency 87 of this historic community was destroyed in addition the author recounts his own survival story as a boy of 13 of his year in a mountain village with his parents and sister the villagers and the partisans who saved them

your story deserves to be widely heard elie wiesel nobel prize winning author and holocaust survivor six year old yolanda avram is rescued by righteous strangers during the holocaust in greece this is her story of courage and survival in the context of dozens of other rescues and shows jews saving themselves and others in audacious and often heroic ways her story is uplifting and focuses on those flickers of light in the vast darkness of evil known in greece as the persecution this little known saga of the common folk outwitting the third reich is a powerful and important story told simply and movingly in cinematic episodes the book is incandescent with empathy and gratitude what a powerful and moving story it is sir martin gilbert official biographer of winston churchill knighted by queen elizabeth ii and author of eighty eight historical books a hidden child in greece is a monumental story that documents her family s miraculous survival in a unique and moving way it gives life to the principle of human dignity and courage as a universal precept this book is a true light unto the nations yaffa eliach author and creator of the first university level holocaust curriculum and the tower of life a 1 500 photograph permanent display at the us holocaust memorial museum in washington dc willis is anne frank if anne frank had lived diana hume george author and educator for me the heart of this book is the family story the real power lays in the intimate story you are able to describe very simply and movingly mark mazower director modern european history columbia university

in this ground breaking work on the ottoman town of manastir bitola robert mihajlovski provides a detailed account of the development of islamic christian and sephardic religious architecture and culture as it manifested in the town and precincts originally a town on the edge of the via egnatia this small provincial town gradually developed into a significant

administrative military religious cultural and intellectual centre for the balkans a vibrant place nurturing progressive multi cultural and multi confessional values with considerable influence on the formation of modern balkan identities the present work is the culmination of thirty years of research using primary source material from archives and chronicles and the monuments themselves for the purpose of both preserving and extending the boundaries of current knowledge it offers a comprehensive biography of a great cultural knot in the balkans and offers a rich source for further use by scholars students and non technical readership alike

what papa told me written by the granddaughter of holocaust survivors is the story of murray a young jewish boy from poland whose courage and sheer will to live helped him survive eight different labor and concentration camps in the holocaust start a new life in america and keep a family intact in the aftermath of his wife s suicide one of the nazis last victims

vol 4 covers the late roman period to the rise of islam focuses especially on the growth and development of rabbinic judaism and of the major classical rabbinic sources such as the mishnah jerusalem talmud babylonian talmud and various midrashic collections

when in 1821 the greeks rose in violent revolution against the rule of the ottoman turks waves of sympathy spread across western europe and the united states more than a thousand volunteers set out to fight for the cause the philhellenes whether they set out to recreate the athens of pericles start a new crusade or make money out of a war all felt that greece had unique claim on the sympathy of the world as byron wrote i dreamed that greece might still be free and he died at missolonghi trying to translate that dream into reality william st clair s meticulously researched and highly readable account of their aspirations and experiences was hailed as definitive when it was first published long out of print it remains the standard account of the philhellenic movement and essential reading for any students of the greek war of independence byron and european romanticism its relevance to more modern ethnic and religious conflicts is becoming increasingly appreciated by scholars worldwide this new and revised edition includes a new introduction by roderick beaton an updated bibliography and many new illustrations

by looking at the very specific case of the greek speaking romaniote and the ladino speaking sephardic communities in southern greece epirus and macedonia this book explores the attitudes and policies of the greek state with regards to the jewish communities both within its borders and in the areas of the ottoman empire it craved evdioxios doxiadis traces the evolution of these policies from the time of greek independence to the expansion of the greek state in the early 20th century telling us a great deal about the jewish experience and the changing face of modern greek nationalism in the process based on the evidence of numerous greek consular reports speeches memoirs

political interviews and coverage of the status and treatment of the communities by the international jewish press state nationalism and the jewish communities of modern greece sketches a detailed picture of the greek political elite and the state s bureaucratic view of the various jewish communities by focusing on the state though not ignoring popular attitudes the book successfully argues that the greek state followed policies that did not conform and often were in opposition to popular attitudes when it came to minorities and the jews in particular by focusing on the jewish communities in modern greece separately the book allows us to recognize how greek governments recognized and used divisions and conflicts between the communities and other minorities to achieve their goals as a result greek state policies can be seen in a new light providing a more comprehensive understanding of the relationship between the jewish people and the greek state using this case study doxiadis then discusses broader questions of state nationalism and minorities in a volume of significant interest for students and scholars of modern greek or modern jewish history alike

the jewish community of ioannina in northwestern greece traces its roots to byzantine times if not earlier in the early 20th century at least half of the community s population emigrated to settle in athens israel and the united states because of economic and religious reasons the cataclysm of the holocaust dramatically decimated the community this steady outward movement created an abrupt rupture of their patterns of traditional culture we are few brings this unique community to life in a series of ethnographic sketches of history and traditional culture in order to understand its intense allegiance to ethnic identity dr annette fromm explores the decreasing inventory of cultural traditions from the patterns of daily life to the rituals and customs associated with life cycle events and holiday celebrations through the periodic return of individuals associated with the jews of ioannina pilgrims a new avenue of the expression of ethnic identity has been created these visits reassure residents that the jewish community of ioannina still exists no matter how dispersed this study is useful for graduate level students and researchers of anthropology and jewish studies

this is the first systematic study of the jews in the greek resistance based on archival research and personal interviews it covers jews in various aspects of resistance in greece and other concentration camps the book is a contribution to the overall story of greek resistance against the nazi occupiers and provides hitherto unknown stories of their contributions to that fight based on interviews and archival research bowman has assembled a preliminary list of over 650 individuals who fought or served with the greek resistance forces these include andartes and andartissas interpreters recruiters doctors spies nurses organizers and a number of non greek jews who volunteered or were trapped in greece during the war years while the murder of nearly 90 of greek jews by the nazis has begun to enter the holocaust story the participation of greek jews in the war against the nazis is virtually unknown greek jews actively fought in the war against the italian and

german invaders veterans and young jewish males and females went to the mountains to fight or serve in various ways in the andartiko among the several greek resistance movements other jews remained in urban areas where they joined different resistance cells whether as active saboteurs or in leadership roles a number of jews appear on the payrolls of force 133 additionally greek jews participated in the sonderkommando revolt in the auschwitz concentration camp in october 1944 while others fought in the warsaw revolt from august to october 1944

founded in the mahoning valley during 1837 a tiny settlement of secular german immigrants grew into one of the most influential centers of jewish life in the midwest home to nationally renowned rabbis and zionist firebrands alike the community produced an astonishing array of leaders in an impressive range of fields throughout the twentieth century this notable legacy ranges from the entertainment juggernaut of warner brothers to the arby s fast food empire and the prominent youngstown sheet tube among many others authors thomas welsh joshua foster and gordon f morgan trace the unique history of one of ohio s oldest jewish communities from its humble beginnings into the challenging climate of the new millennium

this edition integrates the geography of bible lands with the teachings of the bible providing useful commentary for more than 90 detailed maps of palestine the mediterranean the near east the sinai and turkey

the agony of greek jews tells the story of modern greek jewry as it came under the control

of the kingdom of greece during the nineteenth and twentieth centuries in particular it deals with the vicissitudes of those jews who held greek citizenship during the interwar and wartime periods individual chapters address the participation of greek and palestinian jews in the 1941 fighting with italy and germany the roles of jews in the greek resistance aid and rescue attempts and the problems faced by jews who returned from the camps and the mountains in the aftermath of the german retreat bowman focuses on the fate of one minority group of greek citizens during the war and explores various aspects of its relations with the conquerors the conquered and concerned bystanders his book contains new archival material and interviews with survivors it supersedes much of the general literature on the subject of greek jewry

jewish languages from a to z provides an engaging and enjoyable overview of the rich variety of languages spoken and written by jews over the past three thousand years the book covers more than 50 different languages and language varieties these include not only well known jewish languages like hebrew yiddish and ladino but also more exotic languages like chinese esperanto malayalam and zulu all of which have a fascinating jewish story to be told each chapter presents the special features of the language variety in question a discussion of the history of the associated jewish community and some examples of literature and other texts produced in it the book thus takes readers on a stimulating voyage around the jewish world from ancient babylonia to 21st century new york via such diverse locations as tajikistan south africa and the caribbean the chapters are accompanied by numerous full colour photographs of the literary treasures produced by jewish language speaking communities from ancient stone inscriptions to medieval illuminated manuscripts to contemporary novels and newspapers this comprehensive survey of jewish languages is designed to be accessible to all readers with an interest in languages or history regardless of their background no prior knowledge of linguistics or jewish history is assumed

in the ever increasing volume of byzantine studies in recent years there seems to be one very apparent void namely the history and culture of the byzantine jewry its presence and impact on the surrounding convoluted byzantine world between late antiquity until the conquest of byzantium 1453 with the now classic but dated studies by joshua starr and andrew sharf the collective volume at hand is an attempt to somewhat fill in this void the articles assembled in this volume are penned by leading scholars in the field they present bird s eye views of the cultural history of the jewish byzantine minority alongside a wide array of surveys and in depth studies of various topics these topics pertain to the dialectics of the religious literary economic and visual representation world of this alien minority within its surrounding byzantine hegemonic world

ali pasha of ioannina 1750 1822 the ottoman appointed governor of the northern mainland of greece was a towering figure in ottoman greek and european history based on an array of literatures paintings and musical scores this is the first english language critical biography about him in recent decades k e fleming shows that the british and french diplomatic experience of ali was at odds with the orientalist literatures that he inspired dubbed by byron the muslim bonaparte ali enjoyed a position of diplomatic strength in the eastern adriatic in his attempt to secede from the ottoman state he cleverly took advantage of the diplomatic relations of britain russia france and venice as he reached the peak of his powers however european accounts of him portrayed him in ever more orientalist terms as irrational despotic cruel and undependable fleming focuses on the tension between these two experiences of ali the diplomatic and the cultural she also places the history of modern greece in the context of european history as well as that of ottoman decline and demonstrates the ways in which contemporary european visions of greece particularly those generated by romanticist philhellenism contributed to a unique form of orientalism in the south balkans greece a territory never formally colonized by western europe was subject instead to a surrogate form of colonial control one in which the country s history and culture rather than its actual land was annexed invaded and colonized originally published in 1999 the princeton legacy library uses the latest print on demand technology to again make available previously out of print books from the distinguished backlist of princeton university press these editions preserve the original texts of these important books while presenting them in durable paperback and hardcover editions the goal of the princeton legacy library is to vastly increase access to the rich scholarly heritage found in the thousands of books published by princeton university press since its founding in 1905

provides a brief history of albania and calls attention to albania s role in assisting jews from persecution during world war ii

rischin paints a vivid picture of jewish life in new york at the turn of the century here are the old neighborhoods and crowded tenements the rester street markets the sweatshops the birth of yiddish theatre in america and the founding of important jewish newspapers and labor movements the book describes too the city s response to this great influx of immigrants a response that marked the beginning of a new concept of social responsibility

touted as the jerusalem of the balkans the mediterranean port city of salonica thessaloniki was once home to the largest sephardic jewish community in the world the collapse of the ottoman empire and the city s incorporation into greece in 1912 provoked a major upheaval that compelled salonica s jews to reimagine their community and status as citizens of a nation state jewish salonica is the first book to tell the story of this tumultuous transition through the voices and perspectives of salonican jews as they forged a new place for themselves in greek society devin e naar traveled the globe from new york to salonica jerusalem and moscow to excavate archives once confiscated by the nazis written in ladino greek french and hebrew these archives combined with local newspapers reveal how salonica s jews fashioned a new hybrid identity as hellenic jews during a period marked by rising nationalism and economic crisis as well as unprecedented jewish cultural and political vibrancy salonica s jews zionists assimilationists and socialists reinvigorated their connection to the city and claimed it as their own until the holocaust through the case of salonica s jews naar recovers the diverse experiences of a lost religious linguistic and national minority at the crossroads of europe and the middle east

on march 25 1944 the jewish community of ioannina greece was rounded up and deported to auschwitz birkenau of the 1 960 deported 1 850 would never return they would perish in the nazi death camps now on the 60th anniversary of the demise of the jewish community of ioannina kehila kedosha janina synagogue and museum founded in 1927 by jews of ioannina greece is fulfilling its obligation to both those who perished and those who survived by publishing this memorial book introduction page i

a medal of honor recipient looks back at his own service in the vietnam war and ahead to america s future jack jacobs was acting as an advisor to the south vietnamese when he and his men came under devastating attack wounded 1st Lt jacobs took command and withdrew the unit returning again and again saving fourteen lives for which he received the medal of honor here col jacobs tells his stirring story of heroism honor and the personal code by which he has lived his life and expounds with blunt honesty and insight his views on our contemporary world and the nature and necessity of sacrifice if not now when is a compelling account of a unique life at both war and peace and the all too often unexamined role of the citizenry in the service and defense of the republic

cavafy the foremost modern greek poet is a master at presenting a scene an intense feeling or an idea in direct unornamented verse many of the poems are openly homosexual sixty three newly translated poems have been added to the widely praised edition which includes the classic poem ithaca introduction by w h auden translated by rae dalven
